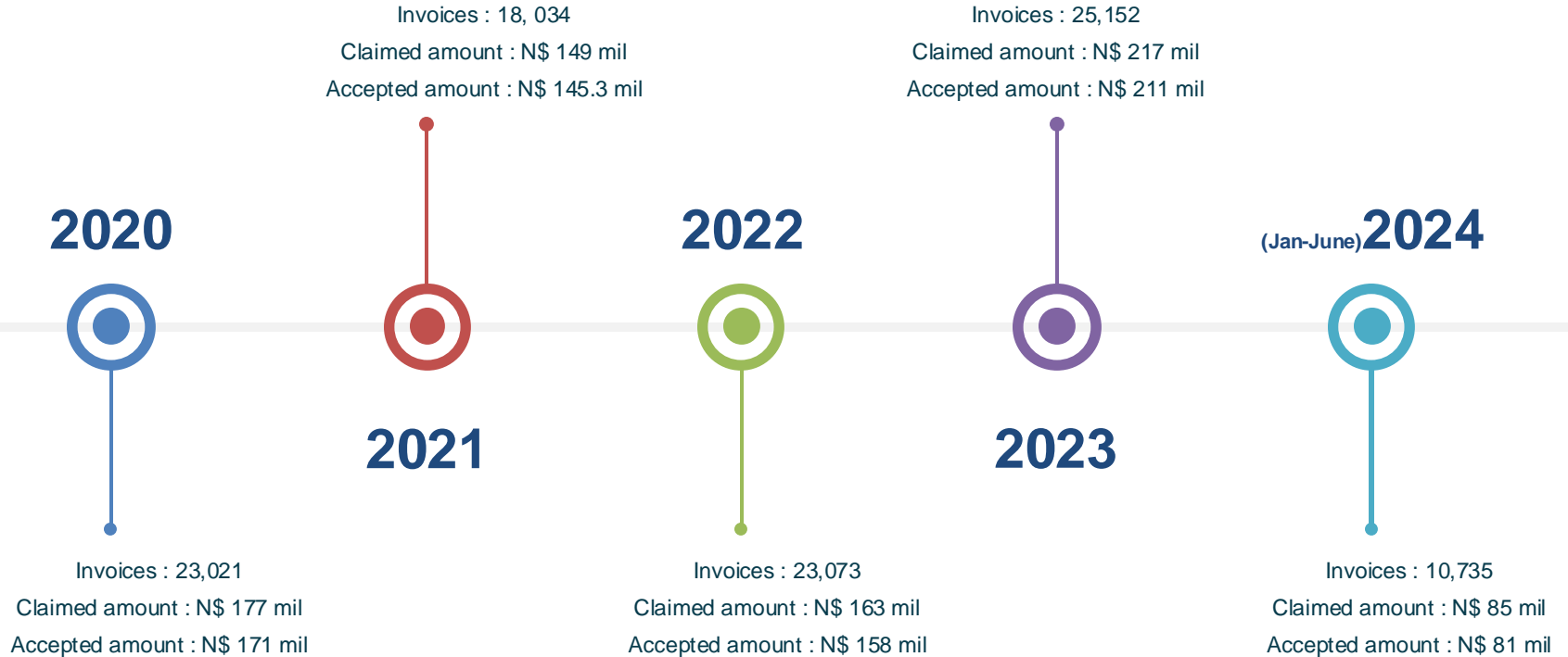

Challenges

- Economic and financial market performance
- Increase in claims and Medical costs.
- Hospital costs
- Geo-political war between Russian and Ukraine affecting fuel prices and consumption.
- Single source of income - fuel levy.

Responding strategy

- Full implementation of the investment strategy.
- Intensify invoice audit.
- Road safety campaigns and interventions.
- Engage GRN on negative impact of fuel levy reduction.
- Negotiation with the Medical Service Providers on the rates – NMAF
- Invest in state facilities
